This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) to 100% in Year 3 and Year 5 in all areas, excluding students on Individual Curriculum Plans (ICPs).
- Increase the percentage of students who are progressing at or above the required growth between Year 3 and Year 5.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English to 95% in 2018.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Mathematics to 95% in 2018.
- Ensure every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing and maintaining a whole school approach to Curriculum and Assessment planning that aligns with the Prep-Year 12 Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Framework.
- Using a regular collection and analysis of data to develop individual student learning goals.
- Teachers and teacher aides working with individual students and small groups of students to achieve set learning goals.
- Providing focussed and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support.
- Moderating with cluster schools to ensure consistency.
- Providing professional development opportunities for teachers and teacher aides to increase capability.
